

Christ, Prince of Peace
Lent - 2010

During Lent we will be using the "Heritage Mass" for the Holy, Memorial Acclamation "A", Amen and Lamb of God. Breaking Bread #865, 866, 870 and 871.

We'll be using a Kyrie named "**Litany of Praise for God's Mercy**"** from the Mass of Redemption by Steve Janco.

Also, we will be using the "**Good News Acclamation**"** for the Gospel Acclamation by James Chepponis. All of the Responsorial Psalms will come from your Respond and Acclaim books though.

Last but not least, to start each mass, we will be singing the "**Introit**"** rather than a "Gathering Song". The "**Introit**" will be an Antiphon and will function much like a Responsorial Psalm. The Congregation sings the "Antiphon," which in our cases will be a text set to the melody of "Lord, Who throughout These Forty Days." At the end of that "refrain" the CANTOR will sing the Psalm verses for the mass and then bring the congregation back in to repeat the "refrain".
